DIRECTIONS TO LAMBETH PALACE, LONDON SE1 7JU

Lambeth Palace is opposite Westminster at the foot of Lambeth Bridge, next to St Thomas' Hospital. There is no signage, but the gatehouse is a familiar landmark.

Entrance:

The big red-brick gatehouse, Morton's Tower, has two big old wooden doors. Please use the iron knocker on the smaller of the doors to summon the gatekeeper.

By Bus:

Lambeth Palace Road: C10, 77, 507 (runs frequently between Victoria and Waterloo) Lambeth Road: 3, 344. The bus stops are identified as Lambeth Palace.



Underground:

Lambeth North: *Bakerloo Line* To St Thomas' and beyond. Approx 10 minutes. Vauxhall: *Victoria Line* Walk (north) towards Westminster. Approx 10-15 minutes. Westminster: *Circle, District, Jubilee Lines* Cross the bridge and walk past St Thomas' Waterloo: *Bakerloo, Jubliee, Waterloo & City, Northern Lines*: Approx 15 minutes walk.

By Car:

Lambeth Palace is in the Congestion Zone.

Limited parking is available in the Palace courtyard and is restricted to disabled visitors for large events. If you do require parking please provide the make, colour and registration number of your car so the gatekeepers are aware prior to your arrival.
